

## Technical Requirements

### Recent Web Browser

We recommend using Internet [Microsoft Edge](#), [Internet Explorer](#) 9+, [Mozilla Firefox](#) 10+, [Safari](#) 6+ or [Chrome](#) 15+

### Compatibility

All our course materials will run on PC, Mac, Linux, iOS (iPad), Android and Windows tablets except for “[Getting Started – Computer Basics for Teachers](#)” which requires Flash support (see below) so it is best suited to PCs, Macs and Windows based tablets.

### Flash Player

You will need the latest version of the free [Adobe Flash Player](#) installed if you are enrolled in the “[Getting Started – Computer Basics for Teachers](#)” course.

### Screen Resolution

For optimal viewing screen resolution should be set to a minimum of 1024 x 768. Click here to learn how to do this with Windows [2000/XP](#) and [Vista](#), Windows 7, 8 and 10.

### Broadband Connectivity

A minimum of 2Mb bandwidth is recommended.
